

## Chester Upland School District Summer Program 2013

## Parent Survey Results Summary

<u>Introduction</u> - During six weeks in the summer of 2013, KnowledgePoints provided a program for Elementary as well as Pre-K/Kindergarten students of Chester Upland School District. The KnowledgePoints Program was offered between 9:00AM and 2:30PM daily, Monday thru Thursday, except for holidays. Elementary students received two hours of tutoring in reading, one hour of tutoring in math and one hour of enrichment activity (provided by the Unity Center, Inc.) each day. Students in the Pre-K/Kindergarten program were provided an integrated academic and enrichment program each day, with a focus on primary phonics and reading.

In order to further enhance the Program as well as measure its success, a survey was developed to compile the opinions of parents with students that participated in the Summer Program. About half were completed on the last day of the Program during the Celebration Ceremony. The balance of the surveys were completed via phone the week following the Program.

<u>Results</u> -Forty two (42) surveys were completed by the parents and the results are as follows:

1. Did your child like the program?

Yes - 100%

Somewhat - 0%

No - 0%

2. Do you think your child will feel more confident returning to school in September?

Yes - 96%

Perhaps - 4%

No - 0%

3. Did you feel like your child will perform better in school?

Yes - 80%

Probably - 20%

No - **0%** 

4. Did you receive enough information about the program as well as your child's progress?

Yes - **84%** 

Sometimes - 14%

No - 2%

<u>Conclusion</u> - As evidenced by the survey results, an overwhelming majority of the parents had a positive experience with this Program. In fact, 100% of the parents responded "Yes" to question #1 - Did your child like the program? In addition there was only one negative response. It was for question #4 - Did you receive enough information about the program as well as your child's progress?

The last question was open-ended and asked "What else would you like to tell us". In general, their comments were consistent with their responses to the six primary questions. They were very positive, as noted above in the **Selected Responses**. Overall, the parent survey responses were extremely favorable and support the success of the Program.
