

**Chester Upland School District
 Summer Program - 2013**

Elementary Student Survey Results Summary

Introduction - During six weeks in the summer of 2013, KnowledgePoints provided a program for elementary students of Chester Upland School District. The KnowledgePoints Program was offered between 9:00AM and 2:30PM daily, Monday thru Thursday, except for holidays. In general, students received two hours of tutoring in reading, one hour of tutoring in math and one hour of enrichment activity (provided by the Unity Center, Inc.) each day.

In order to further enhance the Program as well as measure its success, an age-appropriate survey was developed to compile the opinions of students that participated in the Program. The survey was conducted during the last week of the Program after the students completed their progress test.

Results - Seventy four (74) surveys were completed by the students and the results are as follows:

1. I enjoy coming to my tutoring sessions.

Conclusion - As evidenced by the survey results, an overwhelming majority of the students had a positive experience with this Program. In fact, only about 5% of the total responses were negative (i.e. - "Disagree" or "Strongly Disagree"). The more affirmative responses (i.e. - "Agree" and "Strongly Agree") ranged from 74.3% to 89.2% for the six primary questions. The question with the strongest positive response was #5 - *My grades and homework should improve*. Although somewhat counter-intuitive, but nominal, the question with the most negative comments had to do with student confidence, #4 - *I feel more confident and successful in school*.

The last question was open-ended and asked "*What else would you like to tell us*". We received a number of comments regarding their favorite teachers, overall enjoyment of the Program as well as some of the enrichment activities. In general, their comments were consistent with their responses to the six primary questions. They were very positive and insightful as noted above in the *Selected Responses*. Overall, the student survey responses were extremely favorable and support the success of the Program.
